


WEBINARS

The Guest Speaker for the day was Dr. Anima Tripathi (Assistant Professor, Department of Zoology, BHU, Varanasi) who delivered a lecture on 'Endocrine Disruptors: Impact on Reproductive Health'. 

Modern Analytical Techniques for Standardization of Ayurvedic & Herbal Medicines

A webinar entitled 'Modern Analytical Techniques for Standardization of Ayurvedic and Herbal Medicines' was organized by the School of Pharmaceutical Sciences on 29th May 2021. Dr. Antariksh Katara (Person In-charge, Multani Pharmaceuticals Ltd, Haridwar) was invited as the Guest Speaker. During the session Dr. Katara gave an excellent presentation detailing the modern methods of analysis of herbal medicine in which he emphasized on global acceptance of Ayurveda and traditional medicine by comprehensive and accurate pharmacognostical testing. He focused on various equipments used for standardization and chemical investigation of phytochemicals to ensure the quality features of medicines and to quantify the herbal and Ayurvedic products for quality control testing. He updated the listeners about the most recent instruments and technologies also, like UPLC etc. More than 150 participants attended the webinar.




